- Intake Case Forwarding Decisions (FY 2023):
 - 26.0% of complaints were formaled, while 16.3% were informaled.
- Intake Trends (FY 2021-2023):
 - Total complaints increased 26.0%.
 - The percentage of total complaints authorized for formal petition decreased from 31.0% to 26.0%.

- Detention Risk Assessment Instrument (FY 2023):














