• U.S. Census and Maryland Department of Planning Estimation Data:

• Between July 2018 and July 2022, the Female population (ages 11-17) increased 3.8% (from 259,195 to 268,918).

• Intake Case Forwarding Decisions (FY 2023):

• 17.5% of complaints were formal, while 11.7% were informaled.

• Intake Trends (FY 2021-2023):

• Total complaints increased 99.3%.

• The percentage of total complaints authorized for formal petition decreased from 23.6% to 17.5%.

• Note: Many 2023 cases are still pending court action, so a disposition trend is not presented.

• Detention Risk Assessment Instrument (FY 2023):

• For Pre-Dispositional Detention admissions with a completed DRAI, 15.5% were High risk, 27.6% were Moderate risk, and 56.9% were Low risk.

• Time Frames - Averages (FY 2023):

• Time from offense to intake referral date was 39.7 days.

• Time from intake referral date to case forwarding decision was 21.1 days.

• Time from case forwarding decision to sustained adjudication was 97.5 days.

• Offense Category for Intake Cases (FY 2022-2023):

• The percentage of Crimes of Violence increased from 4.1% to 4.7%.

• The percentage of Felonies increased from 4.9% to 7.2%.

• The percentage of Misdemeanors decreased from 80.4% to 77.9%.

• Commitments for VOP (FY 2021-2023):

• The percentage of commitments resulting from VOP decreased from 37.1% (13) to 7.7% (2).

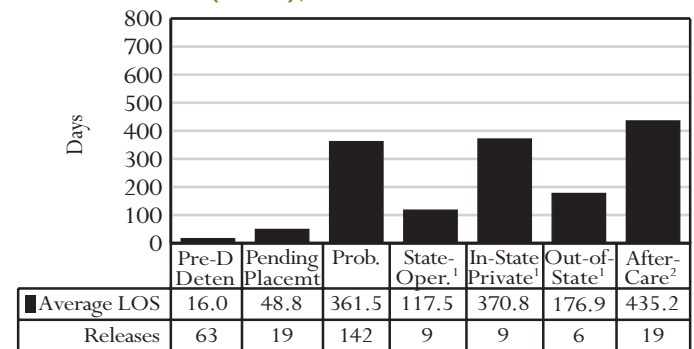

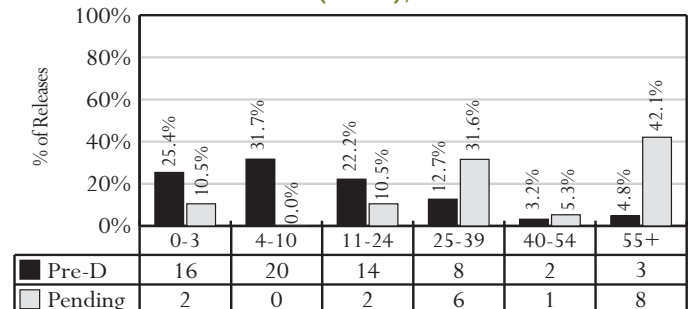
AVERAGE LOS (DAYS), FY 2023 RELEASES
