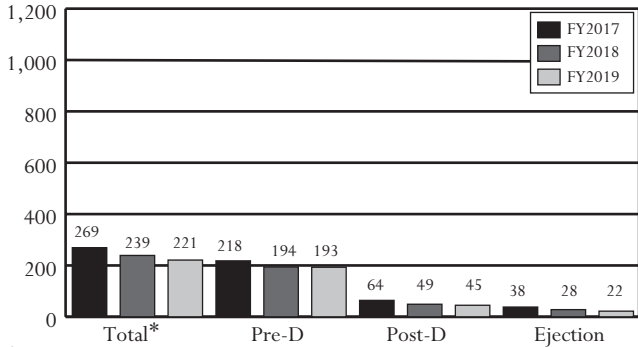

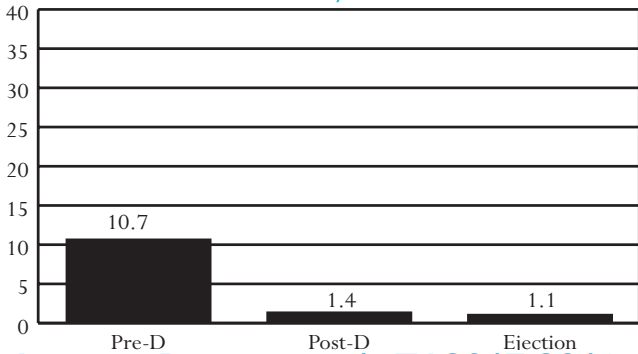

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• Source of Admissions (FY 2019):

- 99.5% of admissions were from regions within Maryland. Of those from out of state, 1 was from West Virginia.

• Admission Trends:

- Total admissions decreased 17.8% between FY 2017 and FY 2019 and decreased 7.5% between FY 2018 and FY 2019.
- Pre-D admissions decreased 11.5% between FY 2017 and FY 2019 and decreased 0.5% between FY 2018 and FY 2019.
- Post-D admissions decreased 29.7% between FY 2017 and FY 2019 and decreased 8.2% between FY 2018 and FY 2019.
- Ejection admissions decreased 42.1% between FY 2017 and FY 2019 and decreased 21.4% between FY 2018 and FY 2019.

• Detention Risk Assessment Instrument (DRAI):

- Pre-D admissions with a DRAI increased 7.2 percentage points between FY 2017 and FY 2019 and increased 6.6 percentage points between FY 2018 and FY 2019.

• Average Length of Stay (ALOS) in Days:

- For cases involving a transfer from facility to facility, the total ALOS is reflected on the statewide pages. The specific facility's page reflects only the ALOS at that particular facility.
- ALOS for Pre-D increased 7.7% between FY 2017 and FY 2019 and increased 18.8% between FY 2018 and FY 2019.
- Post-D ALOS decreased 19.5% between FY 2017 and FY 2019 and decreased 24.7% between FY 2018 and FY 2019.
- ALOS for ejections increased 22.5% between FY 2017 and FY 2019 and increased 11.9% between FY 2018 and FY 2019.

• Pre-D Offense Category (Most Serious Offense) Trends FY 2017-2019:

- The percentage of Crimes of Violence decreased from 24.3% to 21.2%.
- The percentage of Felonies decreased from 16.5% to 10.9%.
- The percentage of Misdemeanors increased from 56.0% to 58.5%.

• Average Daily Population (ADP):

- Overall, ADP decreased 10.8% between FY 2017 and FY 2019 and increased 4.3% between FY 2018 and FY 2019.
- Overall, ADP has consistently been below capacity.

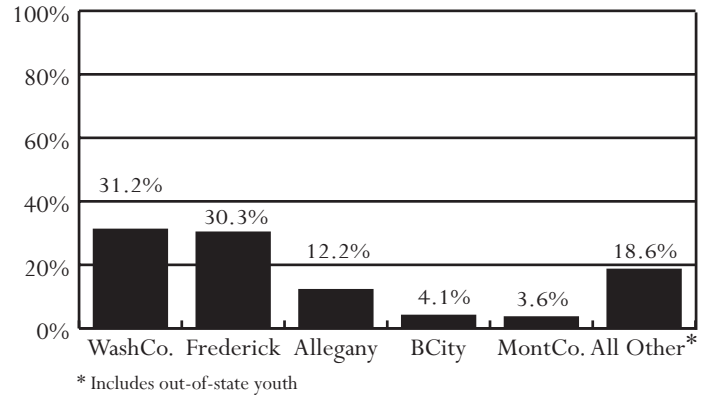

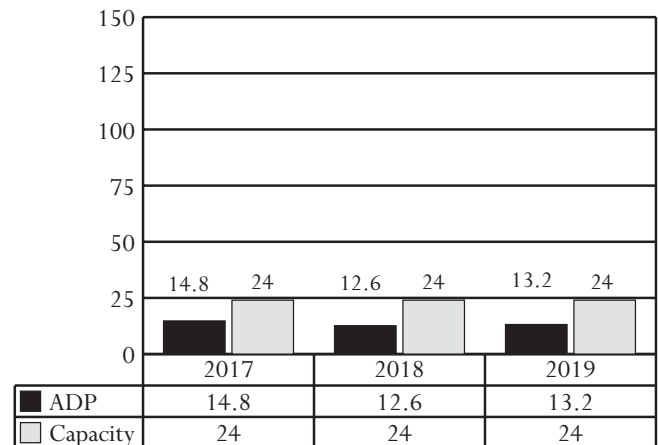
