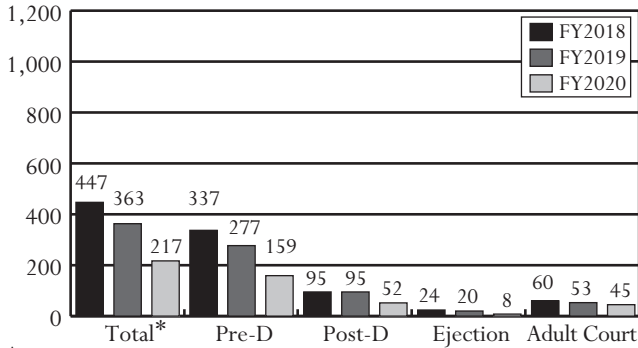

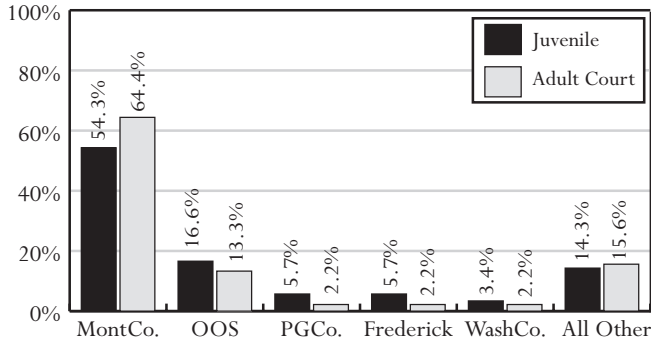

#### Source of Admissions (FY 2020):

- 83.9% of placements were from regions within Maryland. Of those from out of state, 32 were from Washington, D.C.; and 1 each was from North Carolina, Pennsylvania, and Virginia.

#### Admission Trends:

- Total admissions decreased 51.5% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and decreased 40.2% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.
- Pre-D admissions decreased 52.8% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and decreased 42.6% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.
- Post-D admissions decreased 45.3% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and decreased 45.3% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.
- Ejection admissions decreased 66.7% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and decreased 60.0% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.
- Adult Court admissions decreased 25.0% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and decreased 15.1% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.

#### Detention Risk Assessment Instrument (DRAI - See Appendix F) FY2020:

- 57.9% of Pre-D placements had a completed DRAI.

#### Average Length of Stay (ALOS) in Days:

- Statewide pages show overall ALOS including transfers between facilities. Facility pages show ALOS only at that particular facility.
- ALOS for Pre-D increased 32.0% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and increased 7.7% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.
- ALOS for Post-D increased 63.0% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and increased 47.6% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.
- ALOS for Ejections increased 64.8% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and decreased 1.4% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.
- ALOS for Adult Court increased 26.8% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and increased 8.3% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.

#### Pre-D Offense Category (Most Serious Offense) Trends FY 2018-2020:

- The percentage of Crimes of Violence increased from 33.2% to 33.3%.
- The percentage of Felonies increased from 13.9% to 17.6%.
- The percentage of Misdemeanors decreased from 43.0% to 42.1%.

#### Average Daily Population (ADP):

- Overall, ADP decreased 17.8% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and decreased 16.2% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.
- Overall, ADP has consistently been below capacity.
- FY 2020 Pre-D ADP for males was 8.7 and for females was 1.9.
- FY 2020 Post-D ADP for males was 3.0 and for females was 1.7.
- FY 2020 Ejection ADP for males was 0.7 and for females was 0.1.
- FY 2020 Adult Court ADP for males was 9.7 and for females was 1.5.

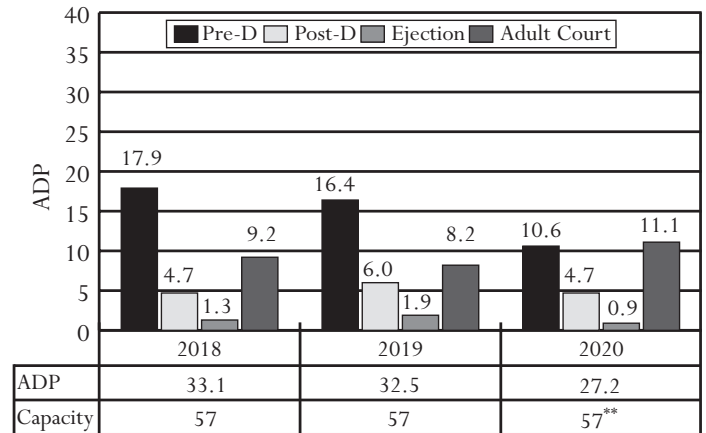

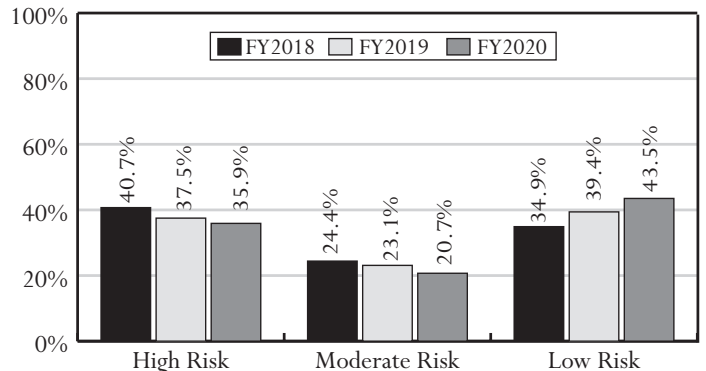
## ADP\* BY ADMISSION TYPE, FY 2018-2020
