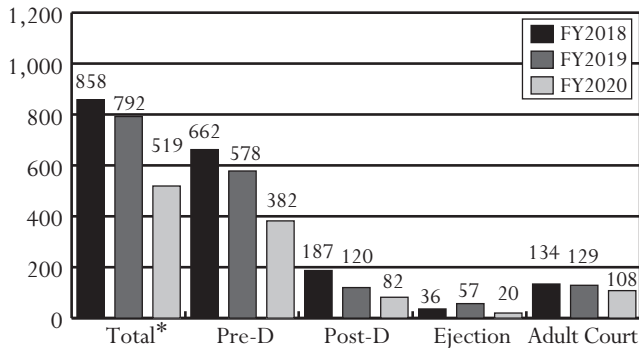

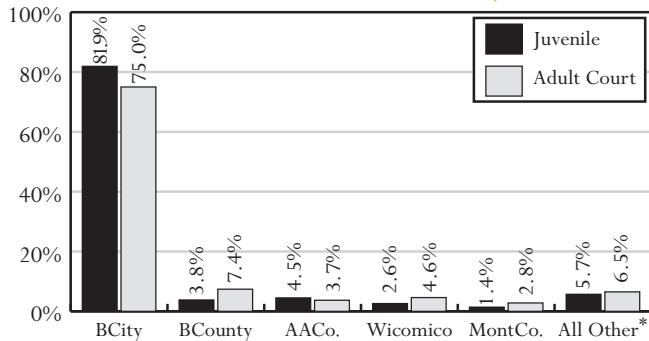

#### Source of Admissions (FY 2020):

- 100.0% of placements were from regions within Maryland.

#### Admission Trends:

- Total admissions decreased 39.5% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and decreased 34.5% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.
- Pre-D admissions decreased 42.3% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and decreased 33.9% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.
- Post-D admissions decreased 56.1% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and decreased 31.7% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.
- Ejection admissions decreased 44.4% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and decreased 64.9% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.
- Adult Court admissions decreased 19.4% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and decreased 16.3% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.

#### Detention Risk Assessment Instrument (DRAI - See Appendix F) FY2020:

- 86.4% of Pre-D placements had a completed DRAI.

#### Average Length of Stay (ALOS) in Days:

- Statewide pages show overall ALOS including transfers between facilities. Facility pages show ALOS only at that particular facility.
- ALOS for Pre-D increased 11.0% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and increased 19.9% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.
- ALOS for Post-D increased 36.4% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and increased 5.9% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.
- ALOS for Ejections increased 56.0% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and increased 36.9% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.
- ALOS for Adult Court decreased 19.6% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and decreased 2.0% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.

#### Pre-D Offense Category (Most Serious Offense) Trends FY 2018-2020:

- The percentage of Crimes of Violence increased from 31.3% to 41.1%.
- The percentage of Felonies decreased from 37.2% to 24.9%.
- The percentage of Misdemeanors increased from 30.2% to 32.7%.

#### Average Daily Population (ADP):

- Overall, ADP decreased 29.5% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and decreased 15.7% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.
- Overall, ADP has consistently been below capacity.

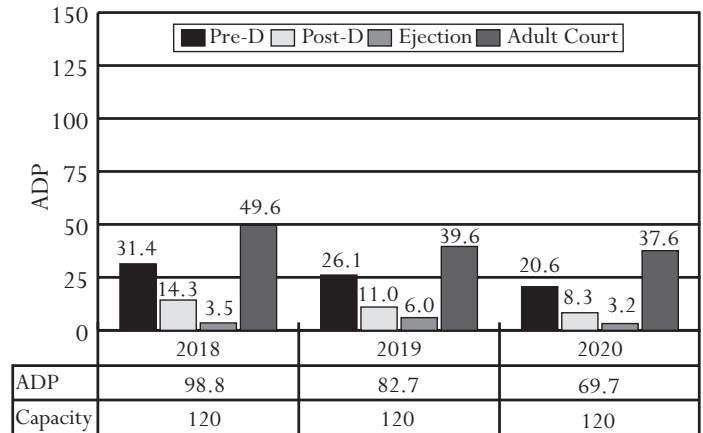

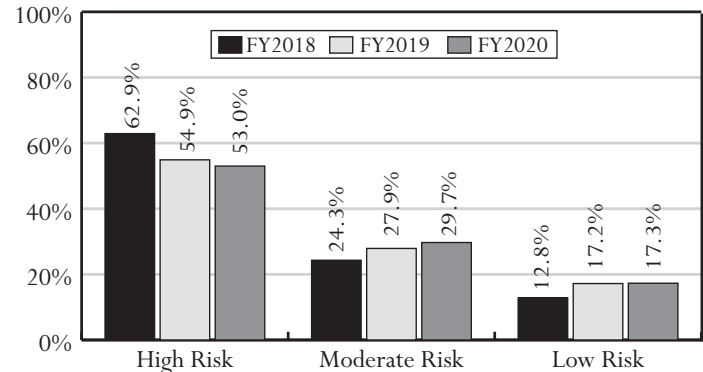
