

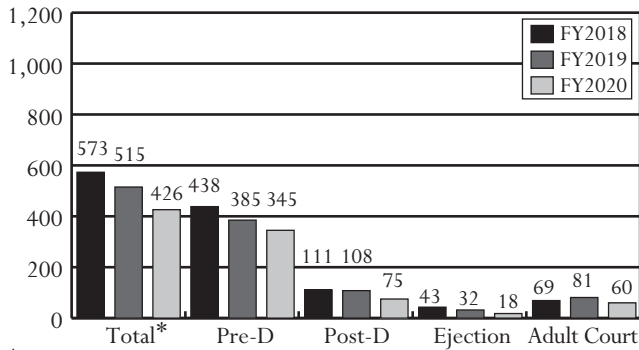

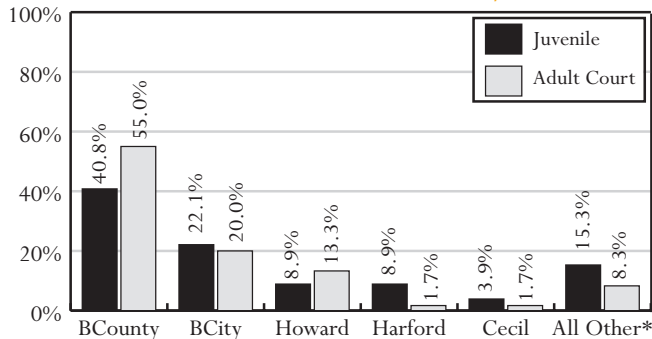

Region II: Central

• Source of Admissions (FY 2020):

- 98.4% of placements were from regions within Maryland. Of those from out of state, 3 were from Pennsylvania; 2 were from Washington, D.C.; and 1 each was from Delaware and Massachusetts.

• Admission Trends:

- Total admissions decreased 25.7% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and decreased 17.3% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.
- Pre-D admissions decreased 21.2% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and decreased 10.4% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.
- Post-D admissions decreased 32.4% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and decreased 30.6% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.
- Ejection admissions decreased 58.1% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and decreased 43.8% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.
- Adult Court admissions decreased 13.0% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and decreased 25.9% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.

• Detention Risk Assessment Instrument (DRAI - See Appendix F) FY2020:

- 84.1% of Pre-D placements had a completed DRAI.

• Average Length of Stay (ALOS) in Days:

- Statewide pages show overall ALOS including transfers between facilities. Facility pages show ALOS only at that particular facility.
- ALOS for Pre-D decreased 1.7% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and decreased 2.0% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.
- ALOS for Post-D increased 29.3% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and increased 40.8% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.
- ALOS for Ejections decreased 17.7% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and increased 2.0% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.
- ALOS for Adult Court increased 17.4% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and increased 5.9% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.

• Pre-D Offense Category (Most Serious Offense) Trends FY 2018-2020:

- The percentage of Crimes of Violence increased from 28.1% to 35.9%.
- The percentage of Felonies decreased from 25.1% to 19.7%.
- The percentage of Misdemeanors decreased from 44.1% to 42.0%.

• Average Daily Population (ADP):

- Overall, ADP decreased 16.0% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and decreased 5.5% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.
- Overall, ADP has consistently been below capacity.

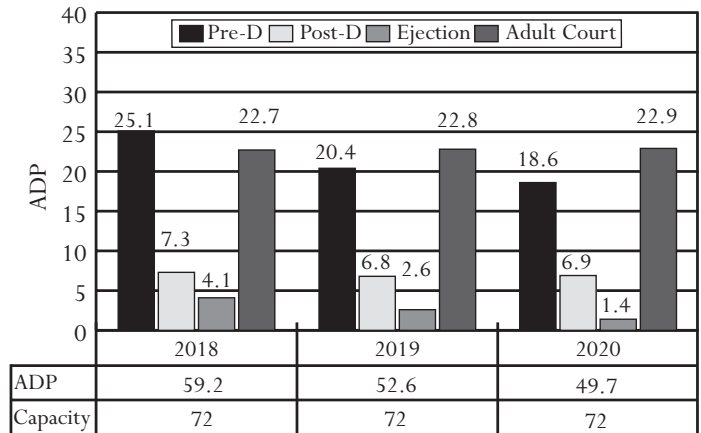

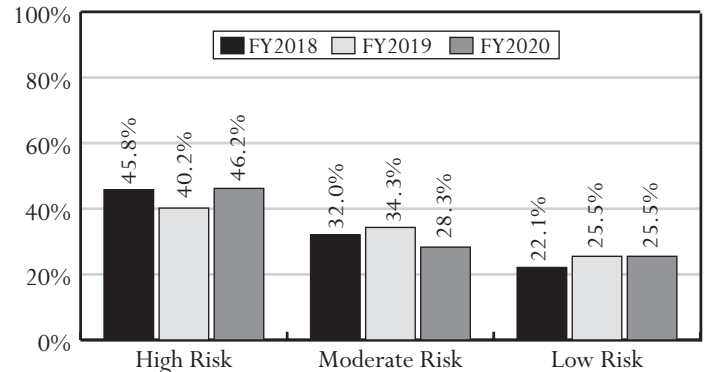
