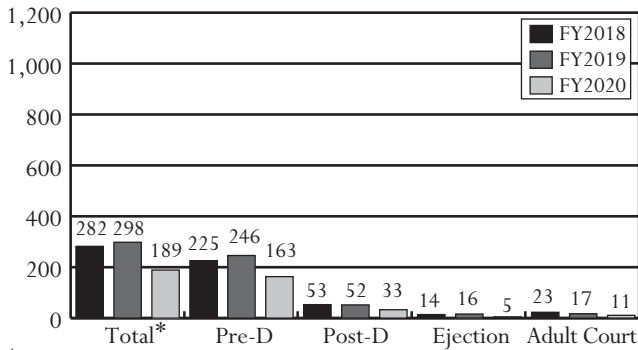

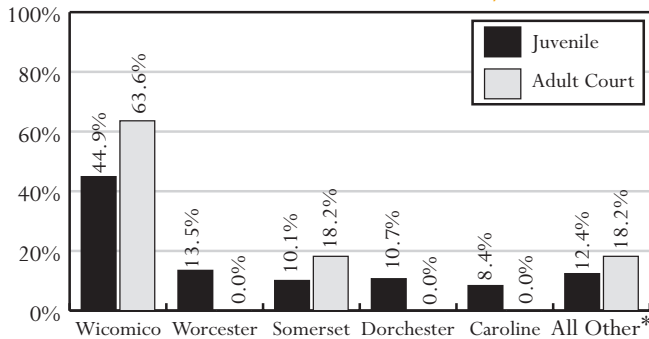

#### Source of Admissions (FY 2020):

- 97.4% of placements were from regions within Maryland. Of those from out of state, 3 were from Pennsylvania; and 1 each was from Florida and Ohio.

#### Admission Trends:

- Total admissions decreased 33.0% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and decreased 36.6% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.
- Pre-D admissions decreased 27.6% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and decreased 33.7% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.
- Post-D admissions decreased 37.7% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and decreased 36.5% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.
- Ejection admissions decreased 64.3% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and decreased 68.8% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.
- Adult Court admissions decreased 52.2% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and decreased 35.3% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.

#### Detention Risk Assessment Instrument (DRAI - See Appendix F) FY2020:

- 90.2% of Pre-D placements had a completed DRAI.

#### Average Length of Stay (ALOS) in Days:

- Statewide pages show overall ALOS including transfers between facilities. Facility pages show ALOS only at that particular facility.
- ALOS for Pre-D increased 21.2% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and increased 21.0% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.
- ALOS for Post-D increased 41.0% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and increased 61.5% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.
- ALOS for Ejections increased 59.3% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and increased 11.0% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.
- ALOS for Adult Court decreased 4.3% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and decreased 9.3% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.

#### Pre-D Offense Category (Most Serious Offense) Trends FY 2018-2020:

- The percentage of Crimes of Violence decreased from 16.9% to 14.7%.
- The percentage of Felonies decreased from 12.4% to 11.7%.
- The percentage of Misdemeanors increased from 61.3% to 66.9%.

#### Average Daily Population (ADP):

- Overall, ADP decreased 21.5% between FY 2018 and FY 2020 and decreased 19.4% between FY 2019 and FY 2020.
- Overall, ADP has consistently been below capacity.
- FY 2020 Pre-D ADP for males was 6.5 and for females was 2.2.
- FY 2020 Post-D ADP for males was 2.1 and for females was 0.6.
- FY 2020 Ejection ADP for males was 0.3 and for females was 0.2.
- FY 2020 Adult Court ADP for males was 2.4 and for females was 0.0.

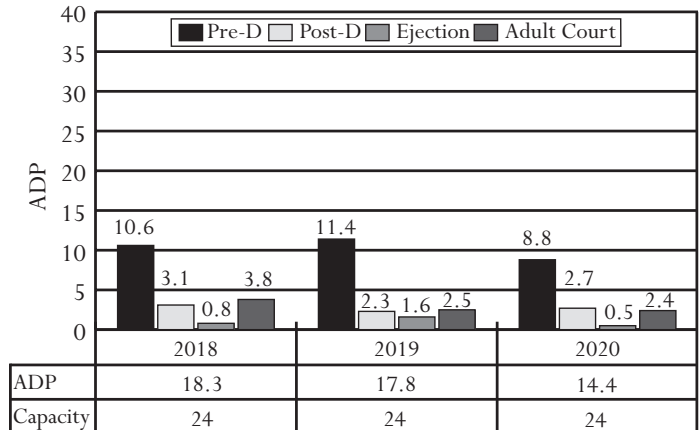

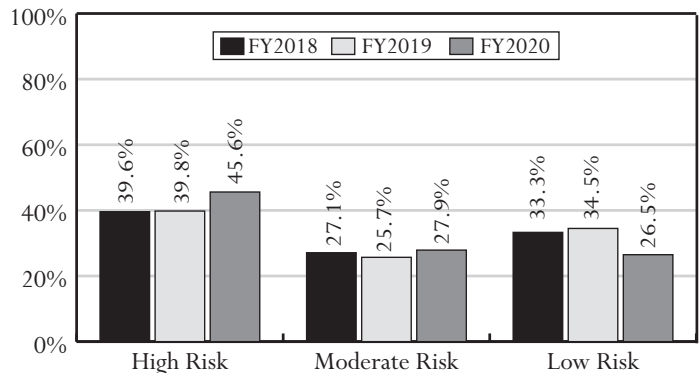
