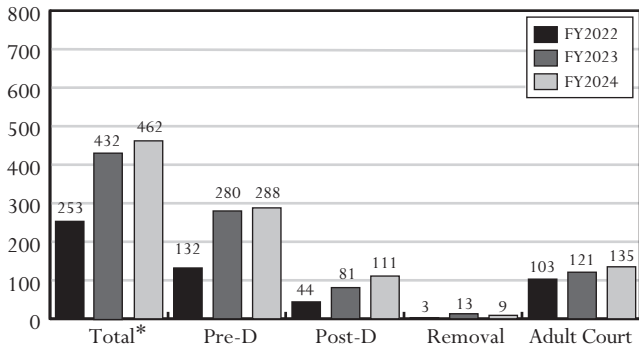

Note: Youth returned to detention following removal from a committed treatment program, with no new offenses requiring court processing, and needing a new committed placement are reported here as “removals”. With the exception of the demographic, offense, and risk level tables/charts, data presented below include youth charged as adults pending transfer (*see pages 114-115 for more detail*).

ADMISSIONS, FY 2022-2024



* Youth can be counted in Pre-D, Post-D, Removal, and Adult Court; therefore, the sum of the status categories may not equal the total.

• Source of Admissions (FY 2024):

- 85.9% of admissions were from Maryland jurisdictions. Of those from out of state, there were 54 from Washington, D.C.; 4 from Pennsylvania; 4 from Virginia; and 1 each from Illinois, New Hampshire, and West Virginia.

• Average Length of Stay (ALOS) in Days:

- For cases involving a transfer from facility to facility, the total ALOS is reflected on the statewide pages. The specific facility's page reflects only the ALOS at that particular facility.

• Pre-D Offense Category (Most Serious Offense) Trends FY 2022-2024:

- The percentage of Crimes of Violence increased from 43.9% to 46.9%.
- The percentage of Felonies increased from 18.2% to 22.2%.
- The percentage of Misdemeanors decreased from 34.1% to 24.7%.

• Average Daily Population (ADP):

- Overall, ADP increased 110.0% between FY 2022 and FY 2024 and increased 21.7% between FY 2023 and FY 2024.
- Overall, ADP has consistently been below capacity.

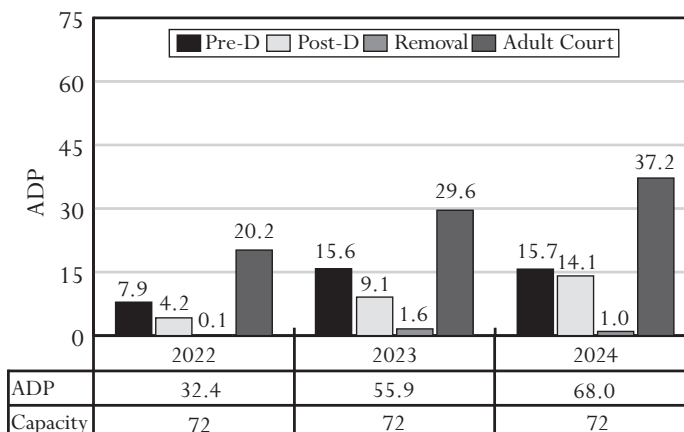

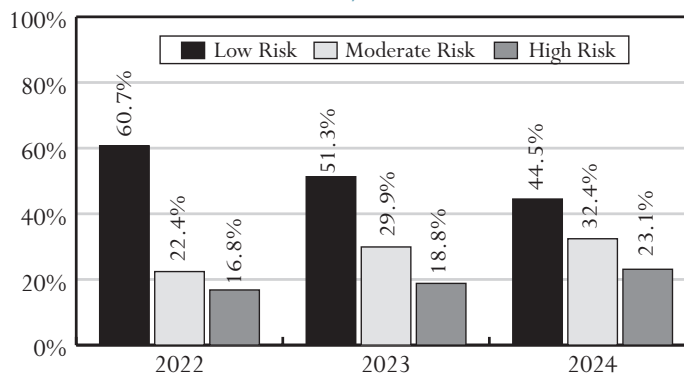
