

- Source of Admissions (FY 2024):
 - 93.1% of admissions were from Maryland jurisdictions. Of those from out of state, there were 4 from Washington, D.C.; 3 from Delaware; 2 from Virginia and 1 each from New Jersey and North Carolina.
- Average Length of Stay (ALOS) in Days:
 - For cases involving a transfer from facility to facility, the total ALOS is reflected on the statewide pages. The specific facility's page reflects only the ALOS at that particular facility.
- Pre-D Offense Category (Most Serious Offense) Trends FY 2022-2024:
 - The percentage of Crimes of Violence increased from 33.7% to 38.4%.
 - The percentage of Felonies increased from 15.8% to 17.0%.
 - The percentage of Misdemeanors decreased from 44.2% to 37.5%.
- Average Daily Population (ADP):
 - Overall, ADP increased 41.4% between FY 2022 and FY 2024 and increased 18.0% between FY 2023 and FY 2024.
 - Overall, ADP has consistently been below capacity.





ADP BY ADMISSION TYPE, FY 2022-2024




PRE-D PLACEMENTS BY RISK LEVEL FOR YOUTH WITH A COMPLETED DRAI*, FY 2022-2024
