DIRECTIVE

Effective immediately, all Community Services Intake Employees shall consider youth charged with **crimes of violence** as a special factor when making intake decisions for youth.

Centralized and Community Services Intake Officers shall adhere to the following decision outcomes for youth charged with crimes of violence:

- When law enforcement requests detention for a youth charged with a crime of violence AND the initial intake decision is not to detain the youth due to a low or moderate DRAI risk score, **the youth must be placed on Community Detention with Electronic Monitoring (CD/EM) supervision.**
- When law enforcement requests detention for a youth charged with a new offense that is a crime of violence AND if the youth is under an order of GPS or CD/EM supervision at the time of the new offense, **the youth must be detained.**
