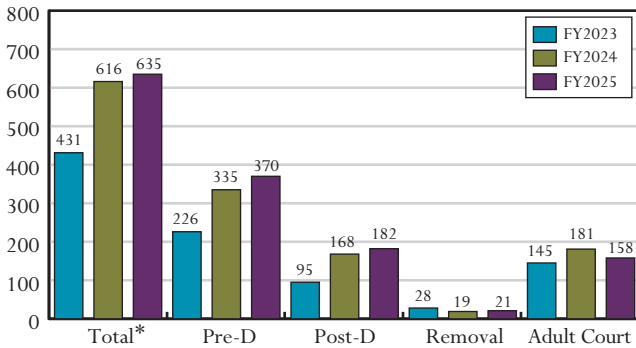

### ADMISSIONS, FY 2023-2025



\* Youth can be counted in Pre-D, Post-D, Removal, and Adult Court; therefore, the sum of the status categories may not equal the total.

#### • Source of Admissions (FY 2025):

- 97.6% of admissions were from Maryland jurisdictions. Of those from out of state, there were 7 from Washington, D.C.; 3 from Pennsylvania; 2 from Florida; and 1 each from Delaware, South Carolina, and Virginia.

#### • Average Length of Stay (ALOS) in Days FY 2023-2025:

- Pre-D LOS increased 13.7%.
- Post-D LOS decreased 11.2%.
- Adult Court LOS increased 14.7%.

#### • Pre-D Offense Category (Most Serious Offense) Trends FY 2023-2025:

- The percentage of Crimes of Violence increased from 38.1% to 43.2%.
- The percentage of Felonies decreased from 30.5% to 26.2%.
- The percentage of Misdemeanors decreased from 30.5% to 28.4%.

#### • Average Daily Population (ADP):

- Overall, ADP increased 42.8% between FY 2023 and FY 2025 and increased 1.9% between FY 2024 and FY 2025.
- Overall, ADP has consistently been below capacity.

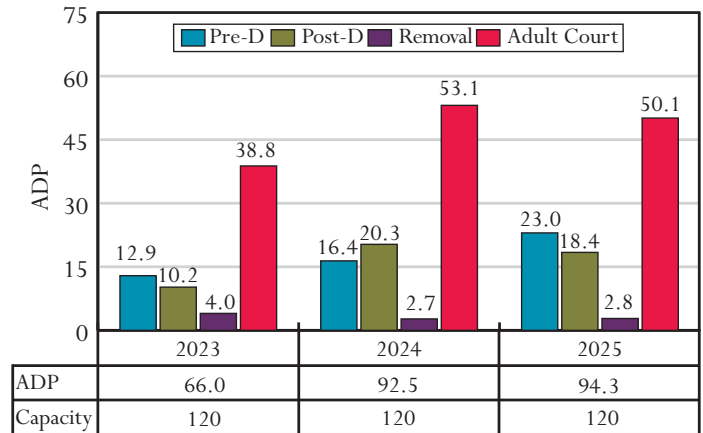

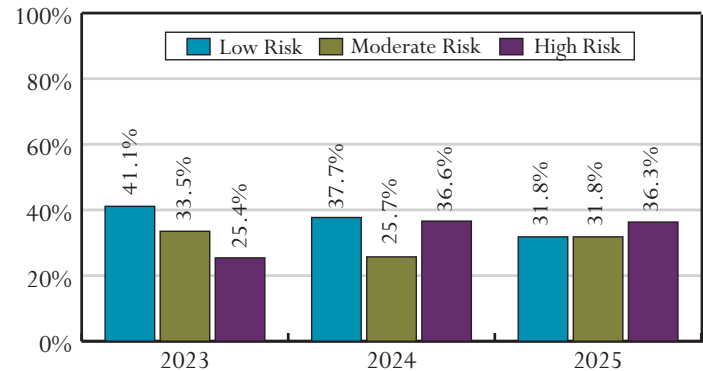

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### ADP BY ADMISSION TYPE, FY 2023-2025

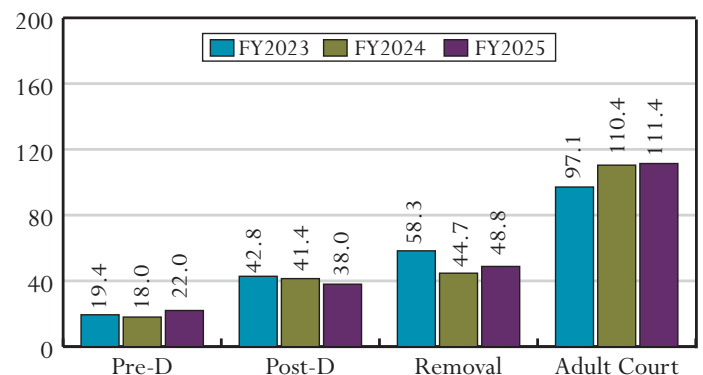


### PRE-D PLACEMENTS BY RISK LEVEL FOR YOUTH WITH A COMPLETED DRAI\*, FY 2023-2025
