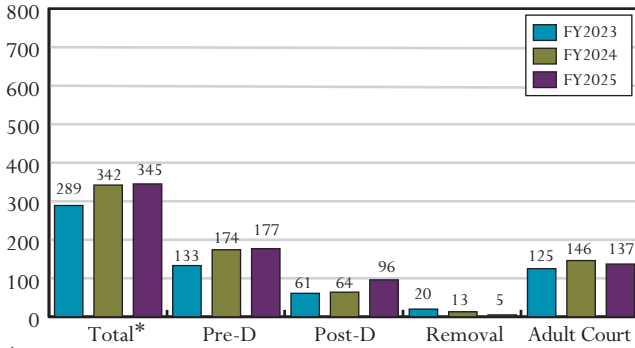

ADMISSIONS, FY 2023-2025



* Youth can be counted in Pre-D, Post-D, Removal, and Adult Court; therefore, the sum of the status categories may not equal the total.

• Source of Admissions (FY 2025):

- 98.6% of admissions were from Maryland jurisdictions. Of those from out of state, there were 2 from West Virginia; and 1 each from Connecticut, Washington, D.C., and Virginia.

• Average Length of Stay (ALOS) in Days FY 2023-2025:

- Pre-D LOS increased 5.0%.
- Post-D LOS decreased 63.9%.
- Adult Court LOS increased 22.3%.

• Pre-D Offense Category (Most Serious Offense) Trends FY 2023-2025:

- The percentage of Crimes of Violence decreased from 44.4% to 37.9%.
- The percentage of Felonies decreased from 33.8% to 22.6%.
- The percentage of Misdemeanors increased from 19.5% to 31.6%.

• Average Daily Population (ADP):

- Overall, ADP increased 22.1% between FY 2023 and FY 2025 and increased 1.3% between FY 2024 and FY 2025.
- Overall, ADP has consistently been below capacity.

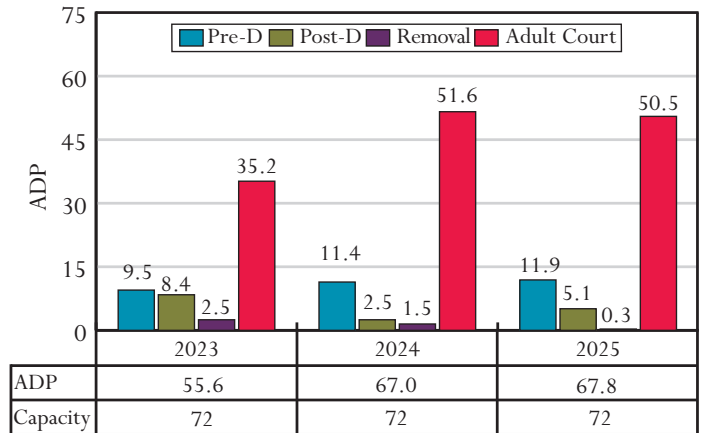

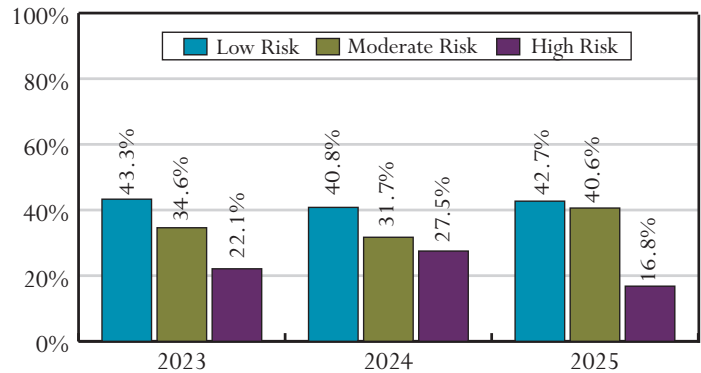

ADP BY ADMISSION TYPE, FY 2023-2025

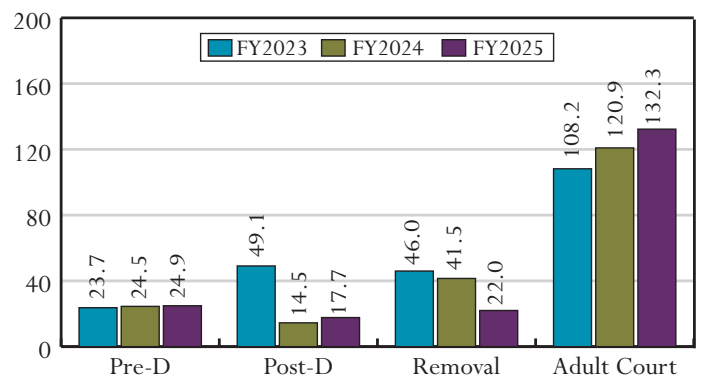


PRE-D PLACEMENTS BY RISK LEVEL FOR YOUTH WITH A COMPLETED DRAI*, FY 2023-2025
