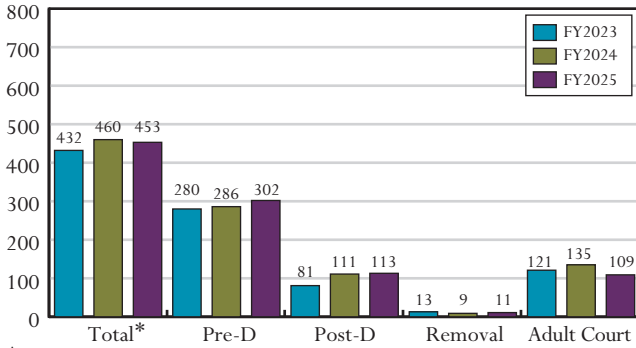

Note: Youth returned to detention following removal from a committed treatment program, with no new offenses requiring court processing, and needing a new committed placement are reported here as “removals.” With the exception of the demographic, offense, and risk level tables/charts, data presented below include youth charged as adults pending transfer (see pages 114-115 for more detail).

ADMISSIONS, FY 2023-2025



*Youth can be counted in Pre-D, Post-D, Removal, and Adult Court; therefore, the sum of the status categories may not equal the total.

• Source of Admissions (FY 2025):

- 84.3% of admissions were from Maryland jurisdictions. Of those from out of state, there were 61 from Washington, D.C.; 5 from Virginia; and 1 each from North Carolina, Texas, and West Virginia.

• Average Length of Stay (ALOS) in Days FY 2023-2025:

- Pre-D LOS increased 2.1%.
- Post-D LOS decreased 0.6%.
- Adult Court LOS increased 30.5%.

• Pre-D Offense Category (Most Serious Offense) Trends FY 2023-2025:

- The percentage of Crimes of Violence decreased from 42.5% to 41.4%.
- The percentage of Felonies decreased from 22.1% to 17.2%.
- The percentage of Misdemeanors increased from 29.6% to 33.4%.

• Average Daily Population (ADP):

- Overall, ADP increased 20.8% between FY 2023 and FY 2025 and decreased 0.6% between FY 2024 and FY 2025.
- Overall, ADP has consistently been below capacity.

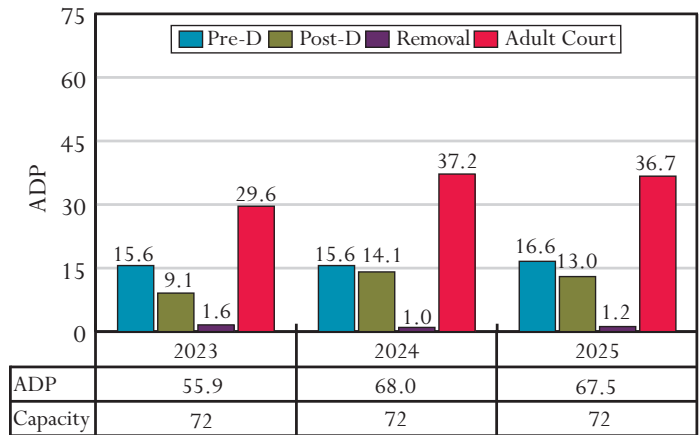

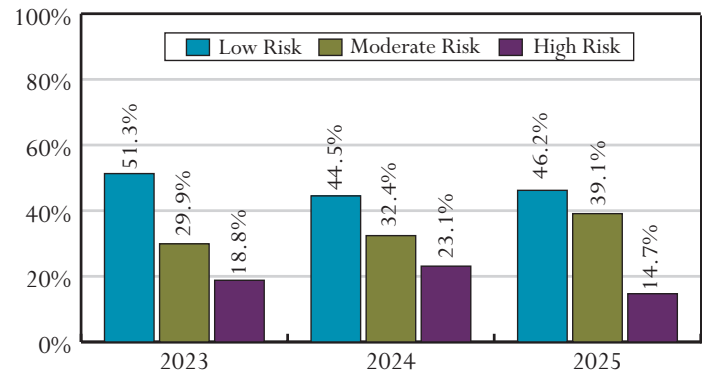

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ADP BY ADMISSION TYPE, FY 2023-2025

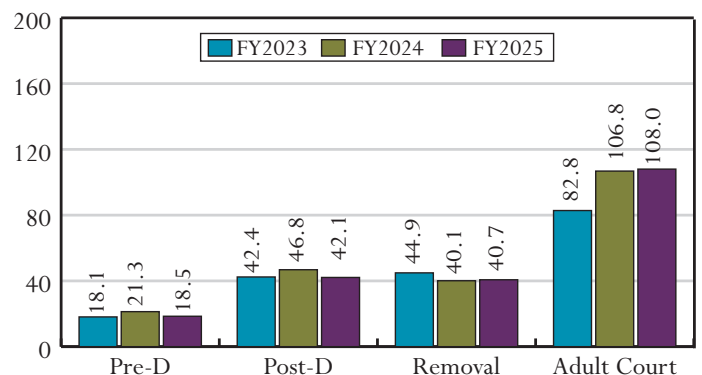


PRE-D PLACEMENTS BY RISK LEVEL FOR YOUTH WITH A COMPLETED DRAI*, FY 2023-2025
