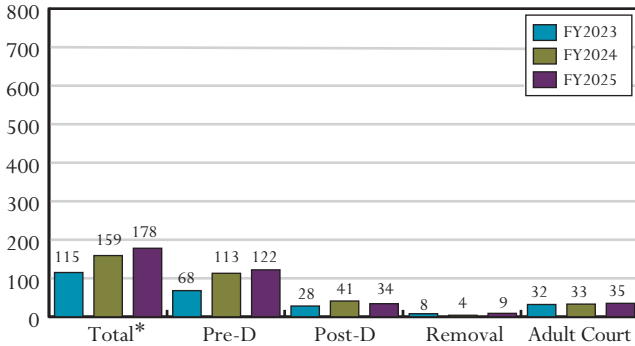

### ADMISSIONS, FY 2023-2025



\* Youth can be counted in Pre-D, Post-D, Removal, and Adult Court; therefore, the sum of the status categories may not equal the total.

#### • Source of Admissions (FY 2025):

- 93.8% of admissions were from Maryland jurisdictions. Of those from out of state, there were 7 from Washington, D.C.; 2 from Virginia; and 1 each from Delaware and Louisiana.

#### • Average Length of Stay (ALOS) in Days FY 2023-2025:

- Pre-D LOS decreased 47.4%.
- Post-D LOS decreased 52.5%.
- Adult Court LOS increased 38.0%.

#### • Pre-D Offense Category (Most Serious Offense) Trends FY 2023-2025:

- The percentage of Crimes of Violence decreased from 38.2% to 21.3%.
- The percentage of Felonies increased from 13.2% to 19.7%.
- The percentage of Misdemeanors increased from 35.3% to 52.5%.

#### • Average Daily Population (ADP):

- Overall, ADP increased 19.3% between FY 2023 and FY 2025 and increased 1.1% between FY 2024 and FY 2025.
- Overall, ADP has consistently been below capacity.

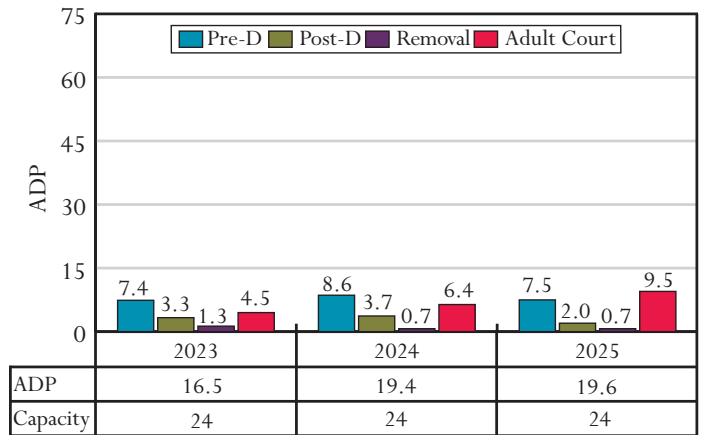

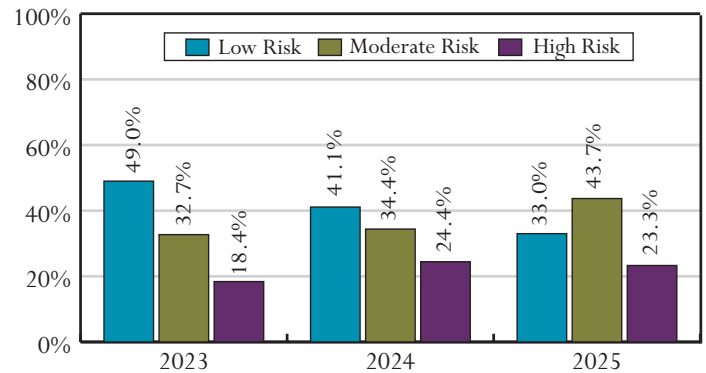

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### ADP BY ADMISSION TYPE, FY 2023-2025

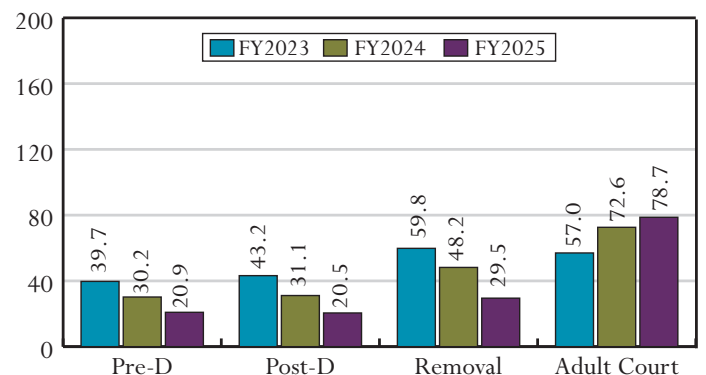


### PRE-D PLACEMENTS BY RISK LEVEL FOR YOUTH WITH A COMPLETED DRAI\*, FY 2023-2025
