



Data Overview January to December 2020

➤ DJS Complaints Statewide Dropped 68% Since January 2020 (1589 to 512)


➤ Temporary Decline in Youth of Color Down as Proportion of Overall Detention ADP

- ➤ Detention ADP Down 47% Since January 2020 (273 to 145)
- ➤ Proportion of Youth of Color in Committed Facilities Down 12% Since January 2020 (80% to 68.1%)
- Commitment ADP Down 59% Since January 2020 (345 to 140)

Total Juvenile Population - 108


12/25/2020 Statewide Detention PopulationTotal Juvenile Detained Population - 44






