- Between July 2018 and July 2022, the Region 4 population (ages 11-17) decreased 1.0% (from 20,931 to 20,721).

• Intake Case Forwarding Decisions (FY 2023):

- 26.0% of complaints were formalized, while 16.3% were informaled.

• Intake Trends (FY 2021-2023):

- Total complaints increased 26.0%.
- The percentage of total complaints authorized for formal petition decreased from 31.0% to 26.0%.

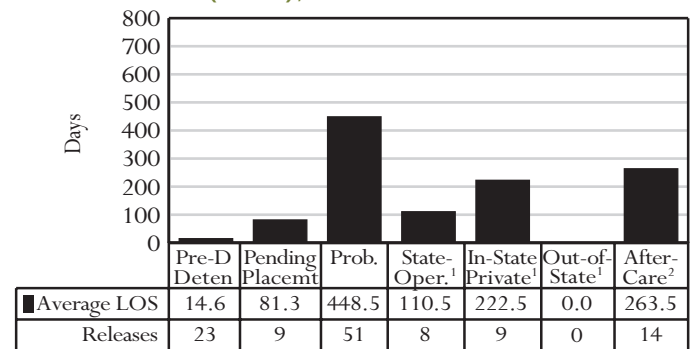

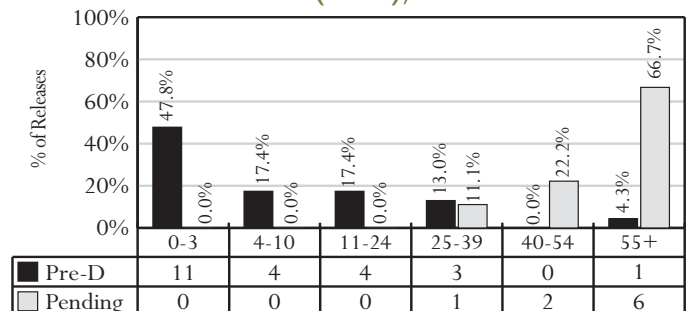
AVERAGE LOS (DAYS), FY 2023 RELEASES

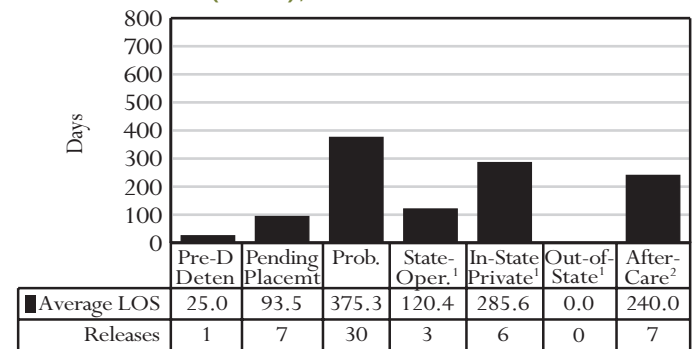

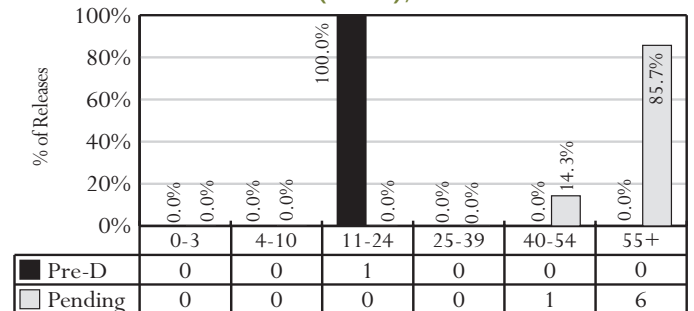
AVERAGE LOS (DAYS), FY 2023 RELEASES

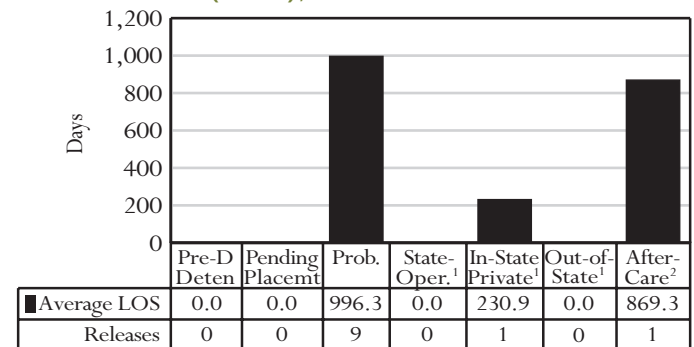

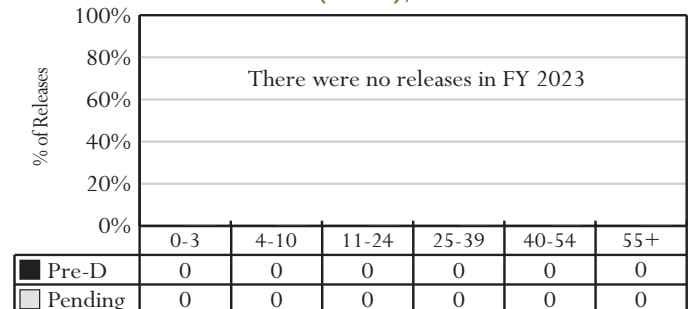
AVERAGE LOS (DAYS), FY 2023 RELEASES

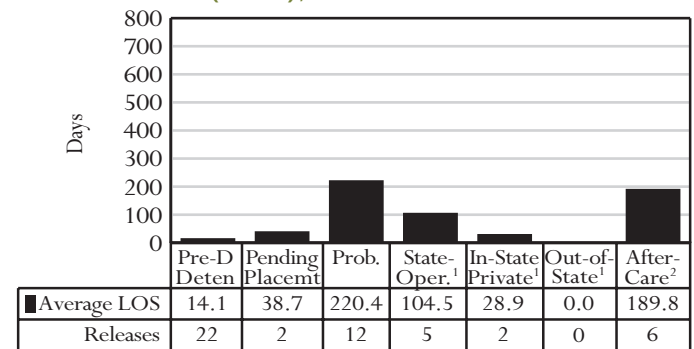

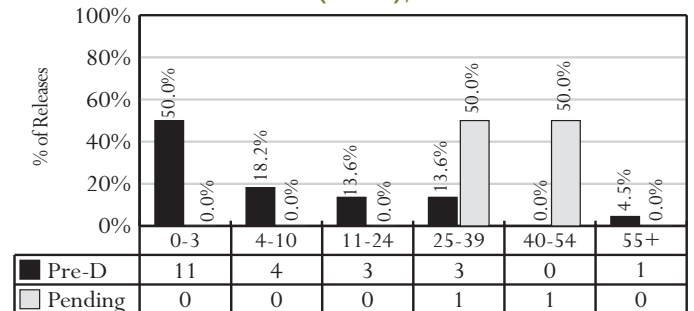
AVERAGE LOS (DAYS), FY 2023 RELEASES
