• Legislative Update

Gavin Patashnick

Gavin Patashnick provided a brief update on some of the legislation that passed during the 2019 Legislative Session of the Maryland General Assembly, two of which directly impact the SAB and were sponsored by DJS.

- HB0169 State Advisory Board for Juvenile Services Duties and Access to Records
 - Expands the duties of the SAB by tasking members with examining circumstances surrounding fatal events involving youth under the supervision of the department and recommending preventative measures.
- SB0072 Membership Department of Juvenile Services State Advisory Board
 - o Expands the membership of the SAB by adding four (4) new members.
- SB0856 / HB0606 Juvenile Justice Reform Council
 - Establishes a Juvenile Justice Reform Council, comprised of numerous legislators, juvenile justice stakeholders and advocacy groups. The council must convene an

advisory stakeholder group and work with the group to conduct roundtable discussion forums seeking public input in all geographic regions of the State.

There was limited discussion because the intent of this meeting was to tour the facility.

The meeting concluded and the remainder of the afternoon was spent touring the Victor Cullen Center.
