



Eastern Region Juvenile Complaints Declined Significantly Over Ten Years


- Eastern Region complaints referred To DJS Intake declined 54% in ten years.
 - Statewide complaints declined 51% over the same period.
- Eastern Region complaints declined 52% Since FY07.
 - Statewide complaints declined 51% over the same period.


Eastern Region Juvenile Complaints Declined Significantly, While Overall Juvenile Population Remained Steady

- Eastern Region overall juvenile population has increased by 0.2% since FY05.
- Eastern Region complaints declined 54% over the same period.



Eastern Region Juvenile Complaints Have Declined in All Categories Over Ten Years


- Juvenile non-violent misdemeanors, which make up the greatest portion of offenses, dropped 48% between FY05 and FY14.
- Juvenile crimes of violence have declined 49% from FY05 to FY14.

The Proportion of Eastern Region Complaints Referred to Court Increased

- 34.4 % of Regional complaints were referred to court by DJS Intake in FY2014, 7.5% more than in FY05. Statewide 53% were referred to court, up 10.7% since FY05.
- 25.2% of Eastern Region complaints were diverted to an informal DJS pre-court case, while Statewide 17.3% were diverted.



Although the Proportion of Cases Referred to Court is Up, the Overall Number Has Declined Over Ten Years

- In ten years the number referred to States Attorney for Formal Petition dropped 42%.
- The number of cases resolved declined 57%, and the number informally adjusted went down 62%.



Eastern Region Juvenile Detention Population Declined Significantly


- Eastern Region daily juvenile population in detention declined 45% in ten years, to just 23 in FY14. Statewide juvenile detained population declined 31% over the same period.
- Eastern Region pre-disposition detention ADP declined 38%.
- Eastern Region pending placement population declined 63%.



Note: In FY2014 DJS detention facilities began to hold more youth charged under adult court jurisdiction. Eastern Region had an ADP of just 0.4 youth held for the adult court. These are not reflected in the above chart.

Eastern Region Juvenile Probation and Commitment Orders Declined Significantly

- Juvenile probation orders dropped 54% in ten years to 230 in FY14.
- Juvenile commitments have dropped 59% in ten years, to 80 in FY14.



Eastern Region Committed Youth Population Declined Slightly Over Ten Years

- Overall daily population of Eastern Region youth committed by the juvenile court to out of home placement declined 12%, from 129 in FY05 to 114 in FY14.
- Statewide daily population of youth committed by the juvenile court to out of home placement declined 26% over the same period.
