


DJS Long Term Trends FY2004 – FY2013


Juvenile Complaints Have Declined Significantly Over Ten Years

- Complaints Referred To DJS Intake Declined 48% in Ten Years
- Showed a 46% Decline Since FY2007




Juvenile Complaints Have Declined In All Categories

- Crimes of Violence Declined 37% in Ten Years
- Crimes of Violence Declined 36% Since FY2007




Cases Referred to the Juvenile Court by DJS Intake Have Dropped

- In Ten Years the Number Referred to States Attorney for Formal Petition Dropped 37%
- Referred Cases Dropped 36% Just Since FY2007




DJS Has Referred a Increased Portion of Complaints to the Juvenile Court

- 52% of Cases Were Formally Requested to be Petitioned by SAO in FY2013
- In FY2007 43% Were Formaled




Detention Populations Have Started to Decline

- Overall Average Detained Population Declined 23% since FY2007
- Pre-Disposition Population Dropped 22%, and Pending Placement Dropped 24% Since FY2007



Juvenile Probation and Commitment Orders Have Declined

- Juvenile Probation Orders Dropped 39% in 10 Years, and 34% since FY2007
- Juvenile Commitments Have Dropped 43% in 10 Years, and 13% since FY2007



Average Juvenile Out-of Home Committed Population Has Declined

- Overall Committed Out of Home Population Has Declined 9% Since FY2007
- DJS-Operated Has Increased 20%, and Private In-State Has Declined 23% Since FY2007
